



Reading at Home

Thank you so much for your continued support with reading. Reading at home is vitally important to your child's development. Reading with your child every day, even if it is only for 10 minutes, can help build their vocabulary bank, build their confidence, develop their love of reading and develop their imagination. Remember your child does not always have to read to you, you can take it turns to read a page each or you could read your child's library book with them. Please remember to sign your child's reading record when you have read together.

Who's that Trip Trapping Over my Bridge?

We hope you enjoyed watching our action video of The Little Red Hen last week. This week, we are reading The Three Billy Goats Gruff. We have retold the story using actions and following the story map. We have also drawn a picture of our favourite part of the story and written a sentence about it. The children are applying their embedded and new phonic knowledge – well done!

Partitioning

In Maths, we have been taking a whole number and partitioning it. For example, 7 (whole number) and partitioned it into 3 parts and 4 parts. The children have used cubes to support their learning and if they were feeling confident, they have had a go at writing it down ($3 + 4 = 7$). We have also explored how numbers can be partitioned in a few different ways, for example, 7 (whole number) and partitioned it into 6 parts and 1 part.

Give us an BAFTA!

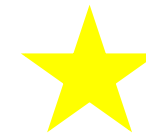
