What have we been looking at?

In Maths, we have revisited number and recognising numbers, Number bonds to 10 and number bonds to 20. We have also been expanding our knowledge in measuring mass and length. The children loved weighing different items from the classroom using the 10g weights. We have been measuring different lengths around the classroom and that we can use centimetres as a unit of measure. In English, we managed to plan a party and then write a recount of the events using the different time words we have been learning about. In Science, we have started to look into different materials. We have been talking about different materials and what properties they have. We worked in groups to order different items in the classroom. In history, we have been looking back at what kind of toys our grandparents/parents liked to play when they were younger. Feel free to let me know some of your favourites by email so we can play or look at them in class. We have started the planning stage for our D.T topic. You may have already heard we are designing and making our own robots that will complete a job/chore that the children don't enjoy doing. Our robots will have at least one moving part.
